#### **Registration Payment Options**

The Satellite Beach Recreation Department offers several payment options for registration fees, including cash, personal checks, credit/debit cards, and money orders. Please note that when using a credit/debit card, a processing fee of 3.04% of the total cost will be added by the processing company. This fee is not retained by the City of Satellite Beach. Checks should be made payable to the City of Satellite Beach unless otherwise noted.

#### **Class Refund Policy**

- Refunds will be automatic if any program is canceled.
- Refund requests must be made no later than 5 full business days before the class or camp begins.
- Partial refunds may be given within 5 full business days, but prior to the start of the program.
- No refunds will be given the day of or after a class begins.

Note: Per the City Financial Policy a refund will only be issued after a check has cleared for 30 days. If a check is returned NSF, additional fees will be charged and participation may be suspended until all fees are paid. For facility refunds, kindly refer to the rental contract for the refund policy.

#### CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH RECREATION DEPARTMENT FEE POLICY

The Recreation Department is supported by municipal tax revenue paid by residents living inside the city limits. Residents enjoy discounted rates for classes, camps and programs. Each program will list both resident and non-resident rates.

#### **FEE POLICY:**

To receive the resident rate, guests just need to live within Satellite Beach city limits at the time of registration. Visitors who reside outside city limits, will receive the non-resident rate.

#### **BACK TO SCHOOL SAFETY**

With the start of a new school year just around the corner, empower your kids with the knowledge and skills they need to stay safe on their way to and from school.

- 1.) Teach the importance of using crosswalks when crossing the street, remind them to look both ways and wait for the signal before stepping off the curb. Encourage them to make eye contact with drivers to ensure they are seen.
- 2.) Encourage your children to wear bright or reflective clothing, especially during early morning or evening walks. Being visible to drivers can significantly reduce the risk of accidents.
- 3.) Teach your child to obey traffic signals and signs, including pedestrian crossing signals. Green means go, but only when it's safe to do so!
- 4.) Remind students to put away electronic devices and remove headphones while walking. Distractions such as texting or listening to music can prevent them from paying attention.
- 5.) Encourage your child to watch out for their friends and classmates while walking to and from school. Remind them that safety is a team effort.
- 6.) For students who ride bicycles to school, reinforce the importance of wearing a properly fitted helmet and following the rules of the road. Remind them to ride with traffic, obey traffic signals, and use hand signals to indicate turns.

#### RHYTHM IN MOTION DANCE PROGRAM

The Rhythm in Motion 10-month dance and gymnastics program begins in the fall and culminates with a recital in May 2026. Most classes participate in the recital and students are required to purchase costume(s) for their performance. <u>Payment Schedules:</u> Class payments may be made in two ways: You may pay the entire 10-month tuition at the time of registration, or you may make 10 equal monthly payments (amount listed above), due on the 1st of each month thru May 2026.

<u>Late Fees:</u> Tuition payment schedule is strictly enforced. Payments not made by the 10th of each month will incur an \$8.00 late fee (per student, per class, per month). Unlimited & Competition students will pay a \$16.00 late fee. If payments fall more than two months behind, students may be denied entry in to class until payment is made.
