

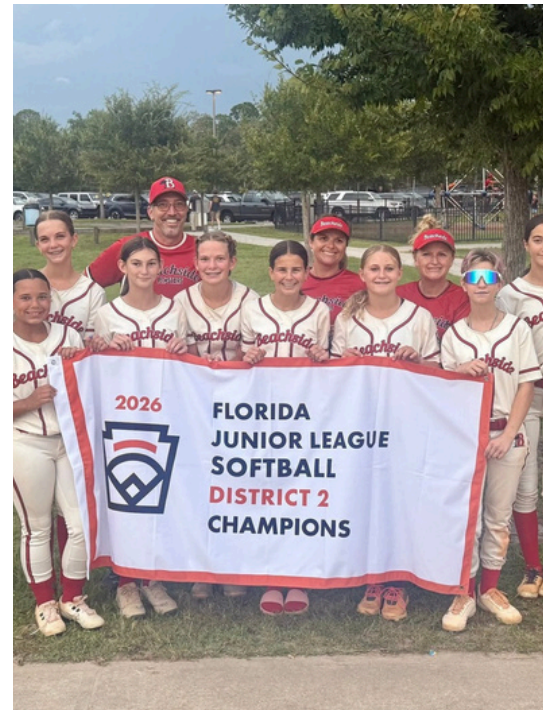

Resident & Non-Resident Fee Policy

The Recreation Department is supported in part by municipal tax revenue from residents living within Satellite Beach city limits. As a result, residents receive a discounted rate of up to 10% for programs, classes, and camps.

Resident Rate: Available to individuals living within Satellite Beach city limits at the time of registration.

Non-Resident Rate: Applies to participants residing outside city limits.

Program Cancellation/ Refund Policy

- Programs may be canceled due to low enrollment. Participants will be notified and offered a refund or transfer option.
- Refund requests must be made at least 5 business days before the program start date
- Partial refunds may be granted within 5 business days prior to start
- No refunds once a class or camp begins

Per City policy, refunds are issued after checks clear (approx. 30 days). NSF/returned checks may result in additional fees and suspended participation. Facility rental refunds follow contract terms.

Photo/Video Policy

Photos and videos may be taken by recreation staff during programs and events for City use in brochures, website, social media, and other promotional materials.

Weather Policy

Outdoor programs may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather. Updates will be communicated via email or phone. Please ensure contact information on your account is accurate.

RHYTHM IN MOTION DANCE PROGRAM

The Rhythm in Motion 10-month dance and gymnastics program begins in the fall and culminates with a recital in May 2027. Most classes participate in the recital and students are required to purchase costume(s) for their performance. Classes are held once a week on the days listed for each and begin the week of August 17th. Registration begins August 3, 2026 online at www.PlaySatelliteBeach.org and in person at the Recreation Office. Classes may be subject to cancellation if the minimum number of enrolled students is not met. All classes are held at the DRS Community Center.

MONTHLY TUITION

45 Minute Class: \$48.75/ \$51.20

1 Hour Class: \$65.00/ \$68.25

1.25 Hour Class: \$81.25/ \$85.30

Registration Fee: There is an annual, non-refundable registration fee per student due upon registration: \$30 SB Residents/ \$33 Non-Residents

Payment Schedules: Class payments may be made in two ways: You may pay the entire 10-month tuition at the time of registration, or you may make 10 equal monthly payments (amount listed above), due on the 1st of each month thru May 2027.

Discounts: During the month of August, a \$5 discount will apply to the annual registration fee. Siblings paying registration fees at the same time will receive an additional \$5 discount.

Non-Competition students taking multiple dance classes will receive a \$5 discount on their second, and each additional class, applied monthly. Satellite Beach Residents receive at 5% discount on monthly tuition and the annual registration fee.

Late Fees: Tuition payment schedule is strictly enforced. Payments not made by the 10th of each month will incur an \$8.00 late fee (per student, per class, per month). Unlimited and Competition students will pay a \$16.00 late fee. If payments fall more than two months behind, students may be denied entry in to class until payment is made.
